



We are pleased to announce the release of version 1.31 of Mobile Threat Net. The following enhancements or corrections have been completed in this version. It is recommended that you read the appropriate manual sections to get the complete details and functionality of these new features. The manual is installed automatically and is available through the Mobile Threat Net *Program group* in your *Start* menu.

- ✓ Added Satellite imagery to the data package.
- ✓ Added Marine zone forecasts to the package these include the Special Marine Warnings, Marine Weather Statements, Coastal Waters Forecasts, Great Lakes Forecast, High Seas Forecasts, Nearshore Marine Forecast, Offshore Waters Forecast and Recreational Forecasts.
- ✓ Improved Sea Surface Temperature graphics.
- ✓ Ability to overlay and individually loop Radar, Tops, and Satellite data.
- ✓ Added the ability to change the range at which mapping features appear. Range can also be set so that feature does not appear (set range at 0,0). Look under Setup -> Map Layers
- ✓ Added the ability to control the number of frames in a Loop as well as the time between each Loop. Look under the Setup -> Loop to set these choices. Note: only two hours of data are stored on your computer, so any settings beyond this will not add any new data to the loop. PLEASE NOTE that the Loop process is processor intensive.
- ✓ Enhanced mapping details for all coasts and inland waterways.
- ✓ Un-decoded METAR data is available with a second click on the station graphic (after the decoded METAR data is visible).
- ✓ Added access to the manual from the **Help** menu
- ✓ Made GPS input more compatible with other NMEA talkers.
- ✓ City Forecast now displays multi-day forecasts.
- ✓ Now after setting the screen resolution and accepting the disclaimer the first time these initial windows will automatically disappear on future launches.
- ✓ Changed the display of the GPS and status data.
- ✓ Added a permanent View Radius display beneath the map window.
- ✓ New XmlLink version 1.28 to support the new products.
- ✓ Manual Version 1.31 to reflect the changes to this new upgrade and enhance existing sections with more graphics.
- ✓ Enhanced and added significantly to the renamed Chapter 5 Frequently Asked Questions.
