



Release Notes Version 1.33

We are pleased to announce the release of version 1.33 of WxWorx on Wings. The following enhancements or corrections have been completed in this version. It is recommended that you read the appropriate manual sections to get the complete details and functionality of these new features. The manual is installed automatically and is available through the WxWorx On Wings *Program group* in your *Start* menu

- ✓ Corrected a bug in the moving map software for when the aircraft was located near the edge of the mapping window.
- ✓ The Sigmet bug has been fixed, all convective areas can be clicked on and will properly display the data associated with the chosen area.
- ✓ Updated the METAR site database to June 2005 station lists.
- ✓ The Graphical User Interface has been cleaned up in all resolutions with buttons added for the new features.
- ✓ **New** product display added – The Freezing level contours in 500 foot increments can now be displayed through its own button.
- ✓ **New** Demo mode added, if a demo data set exists then the demo mode becomes available and the application can be loaded and accessed in demo mode. Data is available from the website and can be downloaded. New events will be added as interesting events happen. While in this mode all parts of the application work and any updates made will be saved.
- ✓ **New** Added a flight plan save and load functions
- ✓ **New** GPS displayed position in moving map mode can be controlled. See the manual and go to Setup->GPS for the new controls.
- ✓ Updated manual to match this release version. See section 4.4.14 for description of the freezing levels, section 4.0.2 for the demo mode information, section 4.7.1 for flight plan enhancements, and section 4.6.4 for new GPS features.
- ✓ New XmlLink version 1.0.31 purges old data during every initial launch. XmlLink will also automatically recognize and correctly configure ports for the certified receivers.

NOTE: The 1.33 upgrade available on the web will **ONLY** work when the installed software is version 1.31a or later. If an earlier version is installed an upgrade to version 1.31a must be made first.
